FAIR CHASE RULES Any animal taken under any of the following circumstances will NOT be considered for a Roche-A-Cri Bowman big game award: yarded in deep snow, helpless in water, helpless on ice, caught in trap, confined behind fences, (i.e. a game farm), in defiance of laws or statutes, or any other method considered by the board of directors majority as unsportsmanlike.
AWARD FOR LARGEST WHITETAIL DEER ANTLERS RULES The deer must be killed in the state of Wisconsin by a current club member. Fair chase rules must be followed. The rack will be scored using the Pope and Young method gross score with no deductions, by the official club scorer. The largest typical or non-typical rack wins the award recognition of name placement on the club plaque. Any racks close enough in score to cause dispute as determined by the club scorer will be assessed by an official Pope and Young scorer. The board of directors will decide the disposition of a tie. Award recognition is placement of name on club plaque.
AWARD FOR HEAVIEST WHITETAIL DEER RULES The deer must be killed in the state of Wisconsin by a current club member. Fair chase rules must be followed. The weight will be performed on the official club scale and recorded on the big game form submitted by the member who harvested it and verified at the official scale at the time of weighing by a second current club member with both members signing the big game form, or weighed on a certified scale with a signed receipt from the business possessing the scale. Award recognition is placement of name on club plaque.
A qualifying animal may win both largest antler and heaviest whitetail. Big game form must be turned in by January 15th, to be considered for awards. Proof of license and tag numbers will be required for antlers submitted without the animal carcass. A yearly harvest chevron is awarded for any big game harvest in the calendar award year. First kill awards are only given once for the first kill of any of the below listed animals.
